Using an integrated and person centred approach, we personalise services so people can achieve outcomes and lead active and fulfilling lives in their community. We work with individuals at every stage; from assessing needs, designing individual service requirements and providing high quality support.

Support can range from several hours per week in our floating support services to up to 24 hours a day in our supported living services.

My Story

Lisa Howarth

Lisa has Autism and is supported by The SLC Group to live in her own shared tenancy in Lancashire.

Lisa's Senior Support Worker Teresa says; 'It's great to see how much Lisa has progressed. She displayed a lot of challenging behaviour when she first came to us which has gradually reduced over time due to consistency around her staffing and boundaries.'

As with many people with Autism it is important to Lisa that her routine is respected and that she has control and input regarding the way that she is supported.

Teresa explains: "We consult with Lisa before bringing anything new into the house and always plan activities in advance with her. This way she knows what to expect and her anxiety is reduced. Lisa's independence has increased significantly since she first moved in and she is now doing things we were told she would never do, e.g. Lisa loves music and she now uses the CD player on her own. It's great to see Lisa developing her skills and I really enjoy working with her."
