This includes: acquired brain injuries (ABI), complex epilepsy, severe cerebral palsy, vulnerable limb dislocation, Korsakoff's, moving and handling and bathing.

Our Support

Our supported living and floating support services are designed to support individuals with a range of physical disabilities to live independently in their own home or tenancy.

We have found the key to providing successful care and support to individuals with physical disabilities and complex health needs is to create a flexible, enabling and individualised supported living package which meets assessed needs and delivers outcomes.

We work with individuals at every stage including; assessing needs, identifying individual service requirements and providing high quality support.

Support can range from several hours per week in our floating support services to up to 24 hours a day in our supported living services.

My Story

Anne Greenhalgh has been living with a degenerative condition which has affected her speech and movement since she was 12 years old and she lives independently in her own home with support from SLC staff.

Anne's condition can include many symptoms but the most common include a lack of coordination, problems with speaking, a decrease in reflexes and heart muscle disease.

Anne explains: "Everything just takes a bit longer. I have to use a wheelchair now and the condition is degenerative – but each person is different and you can't say exactly what is going to happen."

Nicola Ruff is an SLC Lead Locality Manager and has worked closely with Anne to ensure her support is suited to her needs.

Nicola says: "Since we began supporting Anne four years ago her support has changed considerably. It is now directed by Anne and we plan rotas and support hours around what suits Anne - and that is key."

Anne agrees. "My support works well. It is really important to me that my family, friends and my support staff get along and are comfortable in my home, and with each other. At the moment there is a great mix of people in my life which works well."
